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

Message from the president

Dear fellow members of the Academy

I have commented before that although the Academy has had members from over 45 countries there are an awful lot of countries from which the Academy has never had members, including some of the largest such as Indonesia, Brazil and China. So when I was invited to lead a pharmacy group on a trip to China it has therefore been a great opportunity for me to find out more about the history of pharmacy in that country and to identify and meet those involved in the history of pharmacy there.

The trip takes place during the first half of November, so I have been busy preparing the talks I have been asked to give during my visit. There are two to Chinese audiences and one to the group of western pharmacists who have signed up for the trip. The first Chinese group are staff and students at the Union Hospital in Beijing, a former British Missionary Hospital. They have asked me to talk on the history of British pharmacy.

The second Chinese audience are a group of industrial pharmacist, directors of major pharmaceutical manufacturers in the Shanghai area, and government officials. The meeting has been organised by Dr Yueya Yang and Dr Jun Pan, the two ladies who are in charge of the history of pharmacy committee of the Shanghai Pharmaceutical Administration. They have asked me to talk about the development of drugs from natural remedies to gene therapy, and about the emergence of the British pharmaceutical industry.

It is encouraging to find that history of pharmacy is alive and well in China. Dr Yang has recently initiated a project in the oral history of the Shanghai pharmaceutical industry, and this will be a valuable contribution to our understanding of global developments in the field of pharmaceutical production. In Shanghai the industry today is largely generic. The greater challenge for me has been researching the history of pharmacy in China for

western pharmacists. In recent years quite a lot has been written about it by Chinese scholars, but these rarely contain anything in English other than an abstract. Some formal texts relating to Traditional Chinese Medicine, such as the Pharmacopoeia of China and a newly compiled Practical English-Chinese Library of Traditional Chinese Medicine, compiled by Nanjing University and translated by Shanghai University, are available in English, but these are rare examples.

Because of the popularity of Traditional Chinese Medicine outside of China there is of course no shortage of books in many languages about its practices. Rather less common are accounts of the history of Traditional Chinese Medicine, although an excellent account has been written by Liao Yuqun and translated by Li Zhaoguo and others under the title 'Traditional Chinese Medicine: Understanding its Principles and Practices'.

Of particular interest have been those books written by Chinese speaking westerners, an excellent example being that written originally in French by Dominique Hoizey and Marie-Joseph Hoizey and translated into English by Paul Bailey; it was published under the title A History of Chinese Medicine. The last two books include useful information about the 20th century.

In all of these however the focus is on the history of medicine rather than of pharmacy, and although there are usually many references to natural substances used as medicines they rarely consider such questions as how and why pharmacy emerged as a profession separate to medicine, or what the impact of chemical medicine was on Traditional Chinese Medicine.

Such issues remind us that the history of pharmacy is intimately bound up with the history and culture of the country where it is practiced. There is still much for us to share with colleagues in countries which are not at present represented in the Academy, and we must take what opportunities we can to exchange our knowledge, understanding and experience.

New candidates of the Academy of History of Pharmacy.

For this new issue of Communications, we have three new members to propose, one from Turkey (Halil Tekiner, proposed by Bruno Bonnemain, and supported by Afife Mat), one from Norway (Nina Aldin Thune, proposed by Stuart Anderson and supported by Poul Kruse), and one from Iran (Arman Zargaran, proposed by Axel Helmstaedter and supported by Prof. Müller-Jahncke). Their CV is at the end of this issue. If you have any comment or concern, please send it to me. If not, these candidates will be considered as approved and will be received as new members of our Academy at the next congress in Poland.

Elections to the Executive Committee

The names of the officers of the Academy's Executive Committee are laid down in the Academy's Statutes and have remained unchanged since 1952. The committee consists of one president, two vice-presidents, a secretary-general and a treasurer. All work on a honorary, unpaid basis.

Under Article 6 of the Statutes, the president and two vice-presidents are required to be of different nationalities, reflecting where possible the three main languages of the Academy, German, French and English. Members of the Committee are formally elected by the members of the Academy.

The term of office of each officer is four years. On completion of this term it may be renewed for a further period of four years, after which the office-holder must either be appointed to a different office or stand down.

When vacancies arise the secretary-general is required Under the Statutes to send to each member of the Academy the names of the holders of each post and a list of the forthcoming vacant posts. As of October 2016 the position is as follows:

Thus four of the current members must either be re-elected to a different office or stand down. The president has indicated that he will stand down in September 2017, and therefore an election of a new member to the executive committee is necessary.

Under the Statutes any member may be nominated for any post on the Executive Committee. Elections are held in the semester preceding the expiry of the term of office, and

therefore nominations are invited now. Nominations for any one of the above five posts are invited, and should be sent by email to the secretary-general, Bruno Bonnemain, at Bruno.Bonnemain@guerbet-group.com no later than **31 December 2016**.

If an election is necessary ballot papers will be included in the April 2017 number of Communications, and must be returned to the Secretary-General by **30 June 2017**.

The new committee will be announced on **13 September 2017** at the Ceremonial Meeting of the Academy, held during the International Congress for the History of Pharmacy in Warsaw, Poland. At the end of the meeting the president will hand over the Academy's Mueller-Jancke presidential chain of office to his successor.

Informations diverses par pays/Information from the countries :

France

During the first semester of 2016, le French Society of History of Pharmacy has had two sessions in the "Salle des Actes" of the faculty of Pharmacy of Paris-Descartes, the 30th of March and the 8th of june 2016, with 8 présentations, including two from O. Lafont.

At the same time two new issues of our Journal "Revue d'histoire de la pharmacie" were published (n°389 and 390), including 15 studies and 40 various notes.

The 23rd of April 2016, Thierry Lefebvre gave some notions of History of pharmacy for the 50th anniversary of the pharmacy student Association of Angers (ACEPA, France). E. Motte-Florac and O. Lafont represented the French society during the 141st congress of the historical and scientific Works (11-16 April 2016). In may 2016, O. Lafont made a conference on Paracelse during the *European Association of Faculties of Pharmacy* (EAFP) conference, as well as a conference on the treasures of the Interuniversities Healthcare Library (Paris-Descartes) during the Italian Congress of history of pharmacy in Florence.

The 28th of May 2016, a second meeting on Lemery was organized in Lessines (Belgium). The French Society of history of pharmacy was represented by O. Lafont, B. Bonnemain, J. Trouchaud and J.-D. Bourzat.

Thierry Lefebvre organized, the 10th of May 2016, in Chatel-Guyon, a one day meeting on the history of thermalism and its ressources, jointly with the French Society of thermal medicine. T. Lefebvre and C. Raynal gave two presentations. The summaries of this meeting will be published in october 2016 issue of the *Presse thermale et climatique*. SHP was also present at an exhibit in Baugé (France) from July to September on the subject of the containers of drugs.

Au cours du premier semestre 2016, la Société d'histoire de la pharmacie a tenu deux séances dans la Salle des Actes de la Faculté de pharmacie de l'Université Paris Descartes, le 30 mars et le 8 juin 2016, ce qui représente un total de huit communications, dont deux d'Olivier Lafont.

Dans le même temps, deux numéros de la *Revue d'histoire de la pharmacie* sont parus (n° 389 et n° 390), soit au total quinze études et plus d'une quarantaine de notes diverses.

Le 23 avril 2016, Thierry Lefebvre a esquissé quelques notions d'histoire de la pharmacie à l'occasion des 50 ans de l'Association corporative des étudiants en pharmacie d'Angers (ACEPA). Élisabeth Motte-Florac et Olivier Lafont ont représenté la Société d'histoire de la pharmacie à l'occasion du 141^e congrès du Comité des travaux historiques et scientifiques (11-16 avril 2016). En mai 2016, Olivier Lafont a donné une conférence sur Paracelse à la conférence annuelle de l'*European Association of Faculties of Pharmacy* (EAFP), ainsi qu'une communication sur les trésors de la Bibliothèque interuniversitaire de santé (pôle pharmacie) au congrès de l'Académie italienne d'histoire de la pharmacie qui s'est tenu à Florence.

Le 28 mai 2016, une seconde journée Lémery s'est tenue à Lessines (Belgique). La Société d'histoire de la pharmacie y était représentée par Olivier Lafont, Bruno Bonnemain, Jean Troucheaud et Jean-Dominique Bourzat.

Thierry Lefebvre a organisé, le 10 mai 2016, à Châtel-Guyon, une journée d'étude sur « L'histoire du thermalisme et ses ressources », en partenariat avec la Société française de médecine thermale. T. Lefebvre et Cécile Raynal y ont donné deux communications. Les Actes de cette journée paraîtront dans le numéro d'octobre 2016 de la *Presse thermale et climatique*. La SHP a également participé à une exposition à Baugé de juillet à septembre 2016 sur le thème des contenants pharmaceutiques.

On 26th of November 2016, the second Forum of the History of Pharmacy Switzerland "Looking for treasures: Drugs and books as precious testimony of pharmaceutical knowledge" will be held in Berne.

In the focus of the scientific presentations and discussions will be the rich historical heritage of pharmacists, especially by Friedrich August Flückiger and Alexander Tschirch, about the knowledge of medicinal plants. Their investigations, scientific collections and libraries do not only reflect their contribution to the creation and formation of pharmaceutical knowledge in the context of the development of pharmacy into a modern science but can also give new impulses for modern research in plant-based medicine. Before the conference, it will be possible to visit the famous Pharmacognostic collection of Berne and to see representative works and documents concerning the pharmacognosy in Berne.

Le 26 novembre 2016, le deuxième forum d'histoire de la pharmacie Suisse "Recherche de trésors : Médicaments et ouvrages comme témoins précieux de la connaissance pharmaceutique » aura lieu à Berne.

Parmi les présentations, il y aura l'héritage précieux de pharmaciens, spécialement de Friedrich August Flückiger et d'Alexandre Tschirch, concernant les plantes médicinales. Leurs travaux, collections scientifiques et bibliothèques ne montrent pas seulement leur contribution à la création et à la formation de la connaissance pharmaceutique dans le contexte du développement de la pharmacie vers une science moderne, mais peuvent également être le point de départ pour des recherches actuelles dans le domaine des soins par les plantes. Avant la conférence, il sera possible de visiter la fameuse collection de Pharmacognosie de Berne et de voir les travaux et collections à ce sujet.

2. *Relations internationales culturelles des pharmaciens, des chimistes et des médecins roumains au XIXe siècle et du XXe siècle.*



Le 2 Juillet, 2016, à la fin de la réunion, trois jeunes auteurs, ont été désignés comme lauréats pour leurs travaux. Le comité d'évaluation a décidé de distribuer le „*Prix Pharmacien Docteur Constantin Iugulescu*” aux communications suivantes:


