Message du président

Chers collègues membres de l'Académie internationale d'histoire de la pharmacie

Notre année 2022 est bien entamée et nous sommes encore environné par la crise sanitaire que nous connaissons depuis 2 ans sans réelle certitude sur les mois qui viennent. L'Europe est aussi préoccupée par la situation dramatique en Ukraine provoquée injustement par le président russe. Malgré tout cela, nos collègues italiens ont poursuivi leur projet d'accueillir le 45^{ème} Congrès international d'histoire de la Pharmacie à Milan, Italie et on peut se réjouir de cet événement attendu depuis 3 ans. Il montre le dynamisme des historiens de la pharmacie et j'espère que nous serons nombreux à partager cette vision positive de l'avenir. Je vous rappelle qu'il sera possible de faire plus spécialement mais pas seulement des publications sur la médecine préventive, le monde des cosmétiques et de la parfumerie, l'hygiène et les produits issus des stations thermales, etc.

Comme vous le savez, nous avons toujours à cette occasion une soirée, le jeudi 8 septembre pour ce congrès 2022, consacrée à l'Académie internationale d'histoire de la pharmacie. A cette occasion, je rappellerai l'histoire de cette Académie, les membres qui nous ont quitté depuis 2019, et j'accueillerai avec vous les 7 nouveaux membres de notre Académie. Comme les années précédentes, nous remettrons aussi à cette occasion les récompenses décernés par plusieurs pays ou organisations à certains historiens de la pharmacie.

Par ailleurs, comme le veut la tradition des congrès précédents, les membres de notre académie présents à Milan (et eux seuls) sont invités à déjeuner le 8 septembre à midi. Ce sera l'occasion de faire un compte rendu officiel de nos échanges pour l'association que nous avons créée il y a deux ans pour permettre d'ouvrir un compte bancaire au nom de l'Académie. Merci de nous dire dès que possible si vous comptez venir au congrès et répondre à cette invitation. Je remercie particulièrement le comité d'organisation et notre collègue Angelo Beccarelli pour cette invitation et pour l'organisation de la soirée de l'Académie.

Je profite de cet éditorial pour vous rappeler deux choses :

1°) nous ne pouvons plus accepter de nouvelle candidature pour devenir membre de l'Académie avant le congrès de septembre prochain. 2°) vous êtes toujours invité à donner des nouvelles importantes de nos membres et des événements associés à l'histoire de la pharmacie dans votre pays. Mais il est surtout important de nous communiquer régulièrement vos publications et présentations faites dans ce domaine. C'est en effet un moyen de mieux connaître les centres d'intérêt des uns et des autres et de découvrir les nombreux travaux annuels de nos membres. Lors de la dernière édition de Communications en octobre 2021 (qui recensait uniquement la première partie de l'année), nous avons recensé 154 publications ou activités, avec la contributions de nombreux pays : Allemagne, France, UK, Pologne, Roumanie, Danemark, Suisse, Israël, Croatie, Iran, Italie, USA et Espagne. Tous les autres pays sont invités à se joindre à eux !

Message from the president

Dear colleagues, members of the International Academy of the History of Pharmacy

The year 2022 is well underway and we are still surrounded by the health crisis that we have been experiencing for the last 2 years without any real certainty about the months to come. Europe is also concerned about the dramatic situation in Ukraine unjustly provoked by the Russian President. In spite of all this, our Italian colleagues have pursued their project to host the 45th International Congress of the History of Pharmacy in Milan, Italy, and we can rejoice in this event, which has been awaited for three years. It shows the dynamism of historians of pharmacy and I hope that many of us will share this positive vision of the future. I remind you that we are invited to offer oral presentations and posters not only on preventive medicine, on cosmetics and perfumery, and hygiene and products from thermal spas, but also other topics.

As you know, we have an evening at the Congress dedicated to the Academy. In Milan this will be on Thursday 8 September 2022. On this occasion, I will recall the history of the Academy, the members who have left us since 2019, and I will welcome with you the 7 new members of our Academy. As in previous years, we will also present the awards given by several countries or organizations to distinguished historians of pharmacy.

In addition, as has been a tradition at previous Congresses, members of our Academy present in Milan (and only them) are invited to lunch on 8 September at noon. This will be the occasion for the Executive Committee

to formally report the arrangements made two years ago to enable a bank account in the Academy's name. Please let us know as soon as possible if you plan to come to the congress and accept this invitation. Please bring your medal and ribbon. I would like to thank the organizing committee and our colleague Angelo Beccarelli in particular for this invitation and for the organization of the Academy's evening.

I would like to take this opportunity to remind you of two things:

1°) We can no longer accept new applications to become a member of the Academy before the Congress next September. However, you can of course nominate someone for membership after the Congress, provided you respect the rules laid down in our internal regulations, in particular concerning the maximum number of members per country.

Obituaries Nécrologies

Melvin Earles, 1926-2021



It is with great sadness that we report the death of Dr Melvin Earles at the end of 2021 aged 95. Melvin was one of the oldest surviving members of the Academy having been elected in 1974. He was born on Christmas Day 1925 and had a varied and illustrious career. He left school in January 1940 aged 14 and worked as a shop and dispensing assistant. He had a distinguished period of active service during the Second World War which included participation in the 1944 Normandy landings. He was demobilized from the Navy in October 1946.

On his return home he went to Chelsea Polytechnic where he gained his B.Pharm (Honours) degree in 1950. The following year he registered as a

pharmaceutical chemist and was awarded a masters degree in 1953. He attained his PhD in 1962 for a thesis on the history of experimental pharmacology. He then worked for 2 years in research and development at the Wellcome Chemical works in Dartford, before taking the first of several lectureship appointments, mainly at Chelsea.

A sabbatical in 1967/8 saw him appointed as associate professor in the history of pharmacy at the University of Wisconsin. He became an honorary member of their History and Philosophy of Science Department, and for a short time was Acting Director of the American Institute of the History of Pharmacy. He returned to Chelsea and was appointed senior lecturer in pharmaceuticals in 1975. He founded a post-graduate department in the history and philosophy of science and lectured on the history of biological sciences. He was later appointed Head of the Department of Pharmacy at Chelsea College before taking early retirement in 1984.

Melvin was a prolific author of articles on pharmacy and its history. His earliest publications date from 1956 and included contributions to the *Pharmaceutical Journal* and *Annals of Science*. He contributed papers on the histories of hydrocyanic acid, radium, chloral hydrate and salvarsan, along with several biographies for the Dictionary of National Biography. He was an authority on the history of pharmacopoeias and pharmacy education in Britain, publishing a number of important works in book chapters. With C.P. Cloughly and J.G.L. Burnby he wrote *My Dear Mr Bell*, published by the American Institute of the History of Pharmacy in 1987. His history of the Chelsea Department of Pharmacy appeared in 1996.

Melvin was a founder member of the British Society for the History of Pharmacy in 1967, and served two terms as President, first for three years from 1970-1972 and later for two years from 1989-1990. He had previously held the posts of honorary secretary, programme secretary and vice-president. He also served on the committee of the Society of Apothecaries' Faculty of the History and Philosophy of Medicine and Pharmacy, and lectured on its diploma course in the history of medicine.

Melvin will be remembered for his many outstanding contributions to the broad field of the history of pharmacy, but particularly for his work for the British Society for the History of Pharmacy in helping it fulfill its aims of promoting research and interest in the subject.

Annual report 2021

The Circle was limited in its activities in 2021 by the restrictions caused by the corona pandemic, just as in 2020. The Circle's yearly conference, rescheduled from 2020 and to be held in Bussum, had to be postponed again, to 14-15 May 2022. Still, the Circle aimed to reach its members and a larger audience by means of its website (www.kringbenelux.eu), and by frequent digital newsletters, which offered an exciting mix of news, events and developments in pharmacy history in the Low Countries and beyond.

Despite the pandemic, the board decided to make 2021 a festive year, to mark the 75th anniversary of the Circle. Therefore, the Circle's members were addressed to provide information about the iconography in the Low Countries of St. Cosmas and Damian, patron saints of physicians and apothecaries. The result was a special issue of the Circle's bulletin, richly illustrated with all sorts of artistic expressions of the saints. All board members helped to select images and provide captions, and our member Nanno Bolt provided a rich inventory of the iconography of St. Cosmas and Damian, which is available on the Circle's website. An introductory chapter to the issue was written by prof. dr. Hans Geybels (KU Leuven) about the lives of the saints. Furthermore, em. prof. dr. François

Ledermann (Universität Bern) gladly provided a closing chapter about the continuous presence of Cosmas and Damian in lectures, publications, exhibits and so on by the Circle, as these found their way into Pierre Julien's contributions to the *Revue d'Histoire de la Pharmacie*, thereby broadening the significance of the saints in the Low Countries even more. The board hopes that this bulletin will contribute to the Circle's visibility in 2022 as well, and that our other activities can finally resume as planned.

THE ROMANIAN SOCIETY FOR THE HISTORY OF PHARMACY

In time AIHP members from Romania have been the following personalities, doctors and pharmacists: BOLOGA Valeriu Lucian (1892 - 1971), SPIELMANN Josif (1917-1986), IZSÁK Samuel (1915-2007) RÁCZ Gabriel (1928-2013), BAICU Graziella-Lygia (1922-2020), BUTNARU Elena (1948-2022). Currently the following pharmacists, university professors are full members of AIHP: POPESCU Honorius, CARATA Ana, TĂEREL Adriana-Elena.

The year 2021 was an anniversary year for the Romanian Society of History Pharmacy. RSHP has carried out an uninterrupted activity since its establishment until now. In the 30 years of activity, the society has established itself scientifically and organizationally, by organizing national and international scientific events, publications on the history of pharmacy, developing the organizational structure and carrying out scientific activities at the level of sections established in several areas of the country: Bucharest, Braila, Cluj, Iasi, Oradea, Sibiu. The number of members has increased from 47 founding members to over 250 members today.

We mention that for 30 years RSHP has been operating as an independent society based on a statute, being legally established, but until 1991, the society carried out its activity together with the Society of History of Medicine, which had a common path until that date. In fact, the movement of the history of pharmacy in Romania begins in 1921, being stimulated by the French professor Dr. Jules Guiart. The Romanian Society of History of Pharmacy (RSHP) was established on June 13, 1991 in Bucharest at the proposal of the first president Prof.dr. Martian Cotrău (1923 -1998) and the secretary, lecturer col. Dr.Pharm. Constantin Iugulescu (1924-2006). Participating at the International Congress of History of Pharmacy in Prague, 15-20 April 1991, they had the initiative of establishing the Romanian Society of History of Pharmacy, considering the organization of a international congress in Romania, which materialized in 2003. Since the first two years the society has had a medal "Professor Dr. Alexandru Ionescu-Matiu", three classes (gold, silver, bronze).

The scientific activity of RSHP (1991-2021) was materialized in the following events organized within it: 5 international colloquia (which is organized by RSHP every 6 years:1996, 2002, 2008, 2014, 2021), 5 symposiums, 1 International Congress on the History of Pharmacy, 2003, Sinaia, Romania (36th), 28 National Reunions, quarterly meetings of RSHP regional sections, other events organized with other society. The members of the society permanently present scientific papers at national and international scientific sessions.

In 2021, anniversary year for RSHP, the following events took place, adapted to the current conditions (*online / onsite*):

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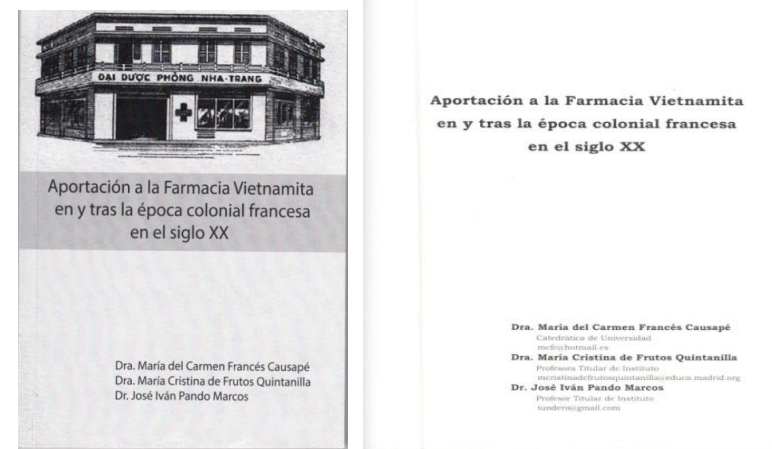

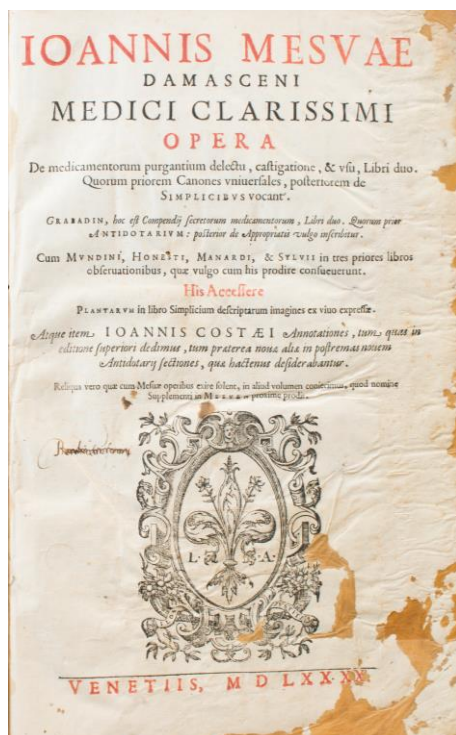

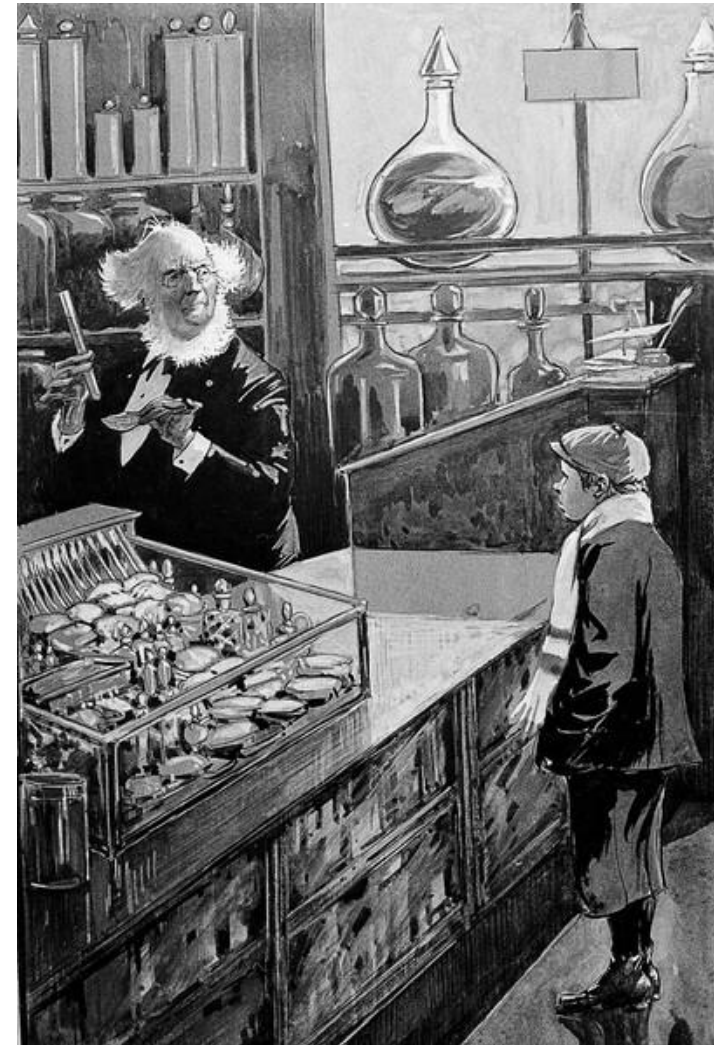
