Message du président

Chers collègues membres de l'Académie internationale d'histoire de la pharmacie

Plusieurs d'entre nous ont eu la chance de pouvoir venir à Milan pour le Congrès international d'histoire de la Pharmacie qui s'est magnifiquement déroulé. D'autres membres nous ont manqué, en particulier nos collègues américains qui ont fortement réduits leur participation à ce congrès en raison du contexte sanitaire et politique avec la guerre en Ukraine. Quoiqu'il en soit, je tiens tout d'abord à remercier chaleureusement Angelo Beccarelli qui, avec son équipe, a fait un travail formidable dans un contexte très difficile. Nous avons pu non seulement profiter de publications intéressantes mais aussi d'un lieu de congrès très agréable et très sûr. J'ai noté que toutes les conférences introductives ont été faites par des membres de notre Académie.

Angelo a également respecté les traditions concernant notre Académie avec le déjeuner offert aux membres présents (au cours duquel nous avons approuvé le projet de rapport moral et de rapport financier de notre association) et la soirée solennelle de l'Académie. Au cours de cette soirée, nous avons pu faire mémoire de nos membres disparus, rappeler brièvement l'histoire de notre académie et accueillir de nouveaux membres : Manfred Frankhauser, de Suisse ; Alberto Gomis Blanco, Antonio Carillo, Raul Rodriguez Nozal, et Esteban Moreno Toral, tous d'Espagne ; Anna Trojanowska de Pologne et Tanja Pommerening d'Allemagne. Tous ces nouveaux membres sont un signe de vitalité de notre Académie et je les félicite à nouveau pour avoir été élus pour nous rejoindre. Je suis sûr que vous aurez à cœur de proposer de nouveaux

membres tout aussi qualifiés (tout en respectant les critères d'éligibilité) pour le prochain congrès qui se tiendra à Belgrade du 4 au 7 septembre 2024.

Au cours de cette soirée, nous avons également remis les prix et médailles à des personnalités qui ont montré leur apport significatif à l'histoire de la pharmacie. La médaille Carmen Frances a été attribuée à John Parascandola (USA) ; celle de la Catedra University à Joao Rui Pita, de Portugal ; Olivier Lafont (France) s'est vu attribuer la médaille Urdang remise par Gregory Higby. C'est également ce dernier qui nous a informé de l'attribution de la médaille Edwards Kremers à Paula S. De Vos (USA). La Schelenz Plaque a été attribuée cette année à Hartwig Graepel et enfin, la médaille Parmentier (France) a été remise par O. Lafont à Angelo Beccarelli. Je suis sûr que vous vous joindrez à moi pour féliciter tous ces historiens renommés pour ces signes de reconnaissance pour leur travail dans le domaine de l'histoire de la pharmacie.

Pour terminer cette soirée, l'Académie italienne d'histoire de la pharmacie a annoncé les gagnants du concours Pier Paolo Daniele destiné à soutenir de jeunes chercheurs en histoire de la Pharmacie. Dix finalistes ont présenté leurs travaux au cours du Congrès et trois d'entre eux ont été distingués au cours de la soirée de l'Académie : Enrico Cevolani d'Italie (1^o), Bastien Delattre de France (2^o) et Nemanja Djordjevic de Serbie (3^o). Nous pouvons espérer que cette excellente initiative sera reprise lors des prochains congrès. C'est un moyen très concret d'encourager les jeunes chercheurs à participer aux congrès et à réaliser des travaux dans le domaine de l'histoire de la Pharmacie.

Notre prochain congrès aura donc lieu dans deux ans à Belgrade (Serbie) où nous pouvons espérer également une belle réussite !

Message from the president

Dear colleagues, members of the International Academy of the History of Pharmacy

Several of us were fortunate to be able to go to Milan for the International Congress of the History of Pharmacy which was held magnificently. We missed meeting other members, in particular our American colleagues who greatly reduced their participation due to the health and political context with the war in Ukraine. Nevertheless, I would like to warmly thank Angelo Beccarelli who, with his team, did a great job under very difficult circumstances. We not only enjoyed interesting presentations and publications but also a delightful and safe congress venue. I noted that all the plenary lectures were given by members of our Academy.

Angelo also respected the traditions concerning our Academy, with the lunch offered to the members present (during which we approved the draft moral and financial report of our Academy), and the Academy's ceremonial evening. During this evening, we were able to remember our deceased members, briefly recall the history of our Academy, and welcome seven new members: Manfred Frankhauser (Switzerland); Alberto Gomis Blanco, Antonio Carillo, Raul Rodriguez Nozal, and Esteban Moreno Toral (all from Spain); Anna Trojanowska (Poland), and Tanja Pommerening (Germany). These new members demonstrate the vitality of our Academy, and I congratulate them again for being elected to join us. I am sure that you will be eager to propose new members who are equally qualified (while respecting the eligibility criteria) for the next congress to be held in Belgrade from September 4 to 7, 2024.

During the evening, we also presented awards and medals to individuals who have made outstanding contributions to the history of pharmacy. The Carmen Frances Medal (Spain) was awarded to John Parascandola (USA), and the Catedra University Medal (Spain) to Joao Rui Pita (Portugal). The George Urdang Medal (USA) was awarded to Olivier Lafont (France) by Greg Higby. Greg also informed us that Paula S. De Vos (USA) had been awarded the Edwards Kremers Medal (USA). The Schelenz Plaque (Germany) was awarded to Peter Hartwig Graepel (Germany). Finally, the Parmentier Medal (France) was presented by Olivier Lafont to Angelo Beccarelli (Italy). I am sure you will join me in congratulating all these renowned historians for these marks of recognition for their work in the field of the history of pharmacy.

To conclude the Academy evening, the Italian Academy for the History of Pharmacy announced the winners of the Pier Paolo Daniele Competition established to support young researchers in the history of pharmacy. Ten finalists gave brief reports on their work at the Congress, and three were given their awards at the Academy evening; Enrico Cevolani from Italy (1st), Bastien Delattre from France (2nd), and Nemanja Djordjevic from Serbia (3rd). We very much hope that this excellent initiative will be taken up again at future congresses. It is a very practical way to encourage young researchers to participate in congresses and to stimulate original work in the field of the history of pharmacy.

Our next congress will take place in two years in Belgrade (Serbia) where we can also hope for a great success!

Angelo Beccarelli

In Treviso at the "Casa dei Carraresi" from 12 February to 23 March 2022, the exhibition "La malattia che viaggia. Dalla peste al covid: imparare dalla storia" (The traveling sickness. From plague to Covid: learning from history) curated by Angelo Beccarelli

In the history of infectious diseases and the struggle undertaken to combat them, Italy has represented the crossroads between medical knowledge and the epidemics that have passed through its territory. The rulers of Italian states, duchies, or republics were able to limit, or at least mitigate, the devastating effects of "unknown diseases" by adopting sanitary measures that were avant-garde for those times. Organised and complex defensive structures were set up with tight, meticulous, and extremely strict regulations.

The exhibition presented in an epidemiological, medical, historical, and geographical sense a world of diseases, epidemics and pandemics with defeats and victories for mankind, shown through forty thematic panels flanked by rare documents from the past and objects from the medical and pharmacological tradition since the 16th century. An itinerary on illness but also on health, prophylaxis, and therapy. There is no lack of religious, artistic, and literary references. A review of original, curious, and unpublished documents made it clear that, today as then, contemporary man, faced with an unknown virus, had to resign himself to following very strict rules of prevention while waiting for new therapies. A parallelism with the present day arose spontaneously, and it could be seen that there was a substantial overlap in the *modus operandi* for circumscribing contagions, even though the means and medical knowledge of the time were clearly inferior. There is much food for thought that shows how much of the past lives on in the present days and

how the fight against epidemics was an impressive fact of faith, responsibility, law, and science.

A wider spread of medical-scientific culture, the importance of pharmaceutical research, greater awareness and confidence in preventive measures and vaccination practices will help us to ensure that the current health emergency becomes history as soon as possible.





Angelo Beccarelli, President of Accademia Italiana di Storia della Farmacia: Main subject of the Congress: Health, Beauty, and Well-Being in the History of Pharmacy

The link with Milan is the “Prospectus Pharmaceuticus” by G. O. Castiglioni (Milan 1668), which is almost certainly the first Official Pharmacopoeia in the world that devotes a specific chapter to topical cosmetic preparations. The legislator proposed to regulate the commonly used preparations, considering them unsafe for side effects. He

established that the pharmacy, managed by a trained and rigorous professional such as the apothecary, was the most appropriate place for their preparations. The publication on the Official Pharmacopoeia made the cosmetic preparations important and comparable to medicines. Hence the close link between cosmetics and pharmacy.

We have received contributions regarding preventive medicine, the world of cosmetics, the art of perfumery, of hygienic and herbal products and everything that concerns the care of the individual and that contributes to achieving and maintaining health, a collective goal that must be pursued today at the highest level and the greatest efforts by every nation.

We have welcomed the free-topic contribution on the history of pharmacy.

The 45th edition of the International Congress has provided an opportunity for all participants to enrich their knowledge and build or strengthen worthwhile links with pharmacy historians from all over the world.




