Nécrologies / Obituaries

Prof. John Parascandola (1941-2024)



It is with great sadness that the American Institute of the History of Pharmacy acknowledges the death of John Parascandola (July 14, 1941 - November 30, 2024), treasurer of the International Academy of the History of Pharmacy in 1981-1989.

For more than a half century, John contributed his time, expertise, and enthusiasm to the field of the history of pharmacy. He received his Bachelor's Degree in Chemistry from Brooklyn College. Soon after receiving his PhD in the History of Science in 1968, John joined the faculty at the University of Wisconsin School of Pharmacy, teaming with Prof. Glenn Sonnedecker to teach the history of pharmacy. From 1973 to 1981, John led AIHP as Executive Director. After his departure in 1983 for Washington, DC, to head the History of Medicine Division of the National Library of Medicine, John remained active in Institute affairs. Most notably, John served as the chief elected officer of the Institute (Council Chair and President) from 1989 to 2007. After stepping aside in that role, he continued to support the field through service on numerous committees and by acting as an expert reviewer of books and submitted papers.

As a scholar, John published widely on the history of pharmacology and public health. After retiring as Historian of the U.S. Public Health Service in 2004, John wrote extensively, including the books *Sex, Sin and Science: A History of Syphilis in America* and *King of Poisons: A History of Arsenic*. His most recent work — *A History of the Development of Alternatives to Animals in Research and Testing* – was published shortly before his death.

He received many awards for his scholarly work in the history of medicine and public health.

Mag. phil. Dr. phil. Andreas Winkler (1959-2025)



Andreas Winkler passed away unexpectedly on January 12, 2025 a few days before his 66th birthday. He came from an apothecary's family in Innsbruck, Tyrol, which had a nearly 450-year-long tradition in pharmacy business. He started his professional career with the study of pharmacy at the University of Innsbruck but according to his primary interests, switched to the study of history before finishing the study of pharmacy. He graduated in 1993 to Mag. phil. and received in 2000 the doctor's degree with the thesis "Aspects of civic life between 1750 and 1850 at the example of an apothecary's family in Innsbruck". Apart from his daily work in his family's pharmacy, history of pharmacy was his passion. He contributed to exhibitions and established a museum of history of pharmacy in 2004 in the premises of the pharmacy building in Innsbruck. The museum's exhibits derived from the rich collections of former pharmacy equipment, pharmaceutical objects, medicinal drugs and books collected for centuries by members of his family.

He was a member of the International Academy for the History of Pharmacy since 2009. He served as president of the Austrian Society for the History of Pharmacy since 2018 and lectured on history of pharmacy at the University of Innsbruck. His last activities concerned the upcoming International Congress for the History of Pharmacy in 2026 held in Innsbruck in remembrance of 100 years of the founding of the International Society for the History of Pharmacy (ISHP). In 1926, Ludwig Winkler, one ancestor of Andreas Winkler initiated the founding of the ISHP in Hall, Tyrol, Austria.

We lost an endearing and cooperative colleague in the field of history of pharmacy whom we all shall miss.

Pologne / Poland

On March 22, 2025, in Kołobrzeg, a plaque commemorating Jadwiga Brzezińska (1924-2024) was embedded on the house where she lived. The Szczecin Branch of the Polish Pharmaceutical Society and the Central-Pomeranian Pharmaceutical Chamber funded the plaque and organized a ceremony dedicated to her life and achievements. Brzezińska was a long-time employee and then a pharmacy manager. After retiring, she defended her dissertation on the history of pharmacies in Kołobrzeg and obtained a doctoral degree. At over 90, she obtained the degree of habilitated doctor. In 1991-2019, she participated in all congresses of the International Society for the History of Pharmacy. Always dressed in white, she was a distinctive figure.

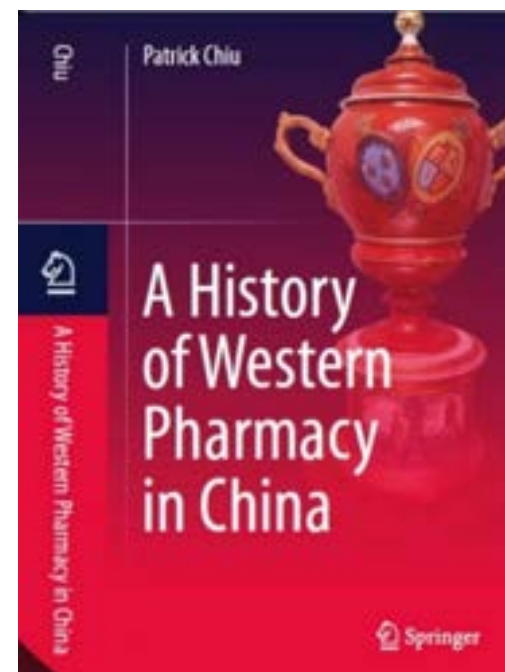

2024 was a highly productive year, and I was fortunate to have "A History of Western Pharmacy in China" published by Springer in January.



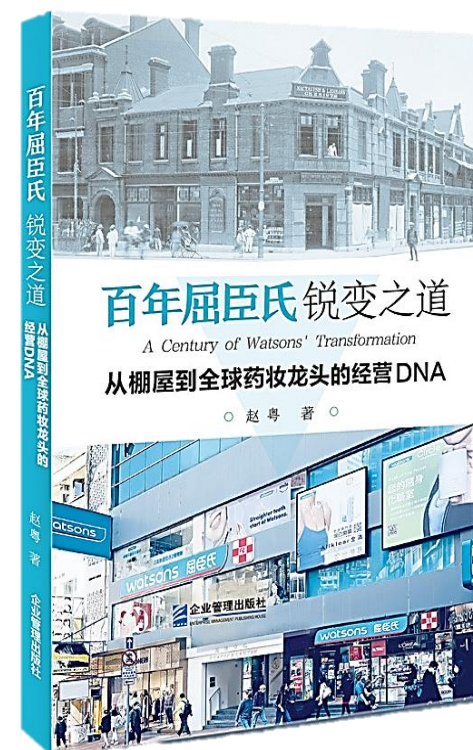

While there have been insightful papers published by leading scholars, this is the first of its kind to document the transmission of materia medica and pharmacy practice from Persia in the 1st century BCE to that of a *Vase de Montre* of the St. Paul's Hospital pharmacy in Hong Kong in 1920 as well as the large-scale use of penicillin during the civil war period from 1946-1949 between the Republican and Communist forces.

My second book, the Simplified Chinese version of "A Century of Watsons's Transformation" was a history of the Canton Dispensary, set up by Dr. James Bradford, a Christian missionary from the U.S., in 1828 under the guidance of Dr. Thomas College, a British East India Company ship surgeon.

Over a period of two centuries, the Dispensary has survived wars, revolutions, and pandemics, growing to become the world's largest retail health and beauty chain with 14,000 retail outlets, including A. S. Watson, Savers, SuperDrug, Kruidvat, and Rossmann, across Asia and Europe.

Commencing in the second half of 2024, I am partnering with Professor Michael Liu of the University of Pittsburgh/Shanghai Jiaotong University as co-editors-in-chief to compile a 1,200-page "Handbook of Chinese History of Pharmacy" to be released by

Springer in the fourth quarter of 2025. We are working closely with historians and pharmacy practitioners in Mainland China, Taiwan, and Hong Kong, as well as a few overseas scholars, including Dr. Noel Golvers of KU Leuven, an authority on Jesuits in Ming and Qing China. The Handbook will be published online and offline by Springer in the fourth quarter of 2025, serving as the first Major Reference Work (MRW) on China's history of pharmacy, from traditional Chinese medicine of the Common Era to the latest developments in pharmaceutical research with novel biopharmaceuticals to treat lung cancers, among China's 350 million smokers.

In September, I was nominated by Dr. Stuart Anderson and seconded by Dr. Briony Harmer and elected by the panel to be a life-member by the prestigious International Academy of the History of Pharmacy.

Commencing in the second half of 2025, I am starting another MRW as co-editors-in-chief, in partnership with Dr. Yolanda Robles, president of the Federation of Asian Pharmaceutical Associations (FAPA), to compile a 1,000-page "Handbook of Asia History of Pharmacy". This MRW will be launched by Springer at the FAPA biannual congress in Bangkok, Thailand, in October 2026.

The first edition will cover Hong Kong, Indonesia, Japan, Taiwan, and Thailand, with each as a separate section. The contents will include the beginnings of pharmacy from antiquity to the present, including traditional practices such as TCM, Jamu and Kampo, the imperial or colonial period since the 19th century until independence or sovereignty change in the 20th century, the development of each branch of pharmacy in the academia, community, hospital, and industrial sectors, as well as the regulatory environment and the roles of pharmacists during the COVID-19 pandemic, and the future of pharmacy in 2050.

Both the "Handbook of Chinese History of Pharmacy" and the "Handbook of Asia History of Pharmacy" will serve as study guidebooks for undergraduate and postgraduate students in the fields of Asian studies, medicine, and pharmacy. This is also the first time Chinese historians and Asian pharmacists will articulate their version of the evolution of pharmacy practice and drug discovery in their respective countries and regions.

It is also my mission to introduce pharmaceutical historians from Asia to become future members of the International Academy of the History of Pharmacy in the coming decade.

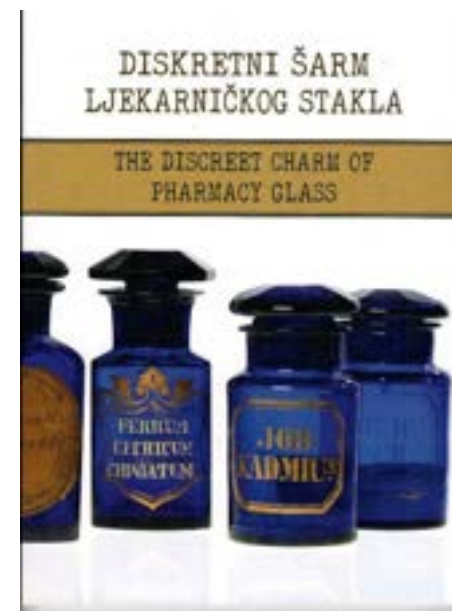

During the General Assembly of the 46th International Congress for the History of Pharmacy, held in Belgrade in September 2024, Halil Tekiner was re-elected as President of the International Society for the History of Pharmacy for a second term.

Among his recent publications is a study co-authored with Prof. Dr. Gregory Tsoucalas (University of Crete School of Medicine) on *Georgios Photeinos and his Hellenic Pharmacopoeia (1835)*, published in *Pharmazie*. This work, printed in Ottoman Smyrna (Izmir), had remained largely overlooked in the literature, likely due to being overshadowed by the official pharmacopoeia of the modern Greek state published under the same title in Athens in 1837. The study examines Photeinos' life, his attempts to modernize and standardize pharmaceutical practices for Greek-speaking communities, and the broader significance of his pharmacopoeia within the context of early 19th-century socio-political transformation.

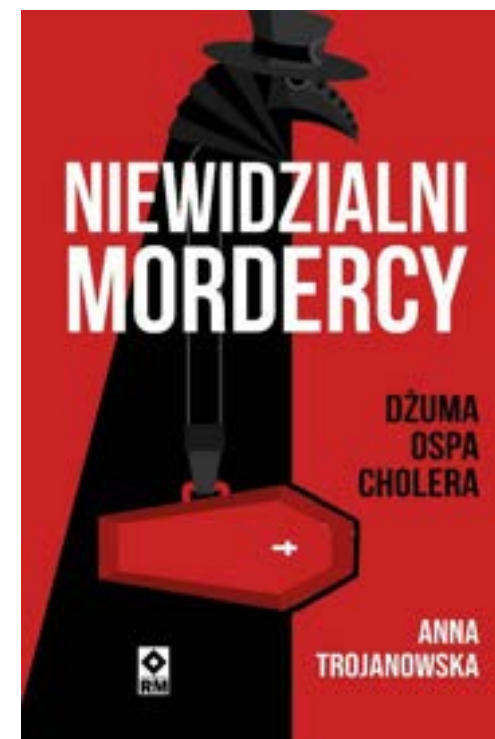
