Message du président

Chers collègues membres de l'Académie internationale d'histoire de la pharmacie

Nous arrivons bientôt au terme de l'année 2024. Le Congrès de la Société internationale d'histoire de la pharmacie nous a permis, comme toujours, de rencontrer nos collègues des différents pays et d'échanger sur l'histoire de notre profession. Ce congrès a également été le lieu de notre réunion habituelle de l'Académie Internationale d'histoire de la pharmacie (voir plus loin). Cet éditorial est pour moi le dernier en tant que président de notre Académie. Il y a en effet maintenant plus de 6 ans comme je préside notre assemblée. Je tenais à vous remercier pour votre soutien tout au long de ces années de présidence. Notre journal Communications montre que nos membres continuent à être très actifs dans la publication d'articles ou la réalisation de conférences sur l'histoire de la pharmacie et on peut s'en réjouir. Malgré tout, on constate que la plupart de nos membres viennent de quelques pays (trop peu) et que la relève n'est pas assurée partout. Il faut donner aux jeunes pharmaciens l'opportunité de participer aux activités des sociétés nationales et aux congrès internationaux le plus souvent possibles.

Comme président, je cède la place à notre collègue Antonio González Bueno, d'Espagne, qui a une très bonne connaissance de l'histoire de notre profession et qui a de nombreuses responsabilités dans ce domaine en Espagne, en particulier la direction du musée d'histoire de la pharmacie (UCB). Docteur en sciences biologiques de l'Université autonome de Madrid (1986), il est professeur d'histoire de la pharmacie et de la législation pharmaceutique à l'Université Complutense de Madrid depuis 2011. Il a contribué à la constitution de la Société espagnole des professeurs universitaires d'histoire de la pharmacie (SDUHFE), dont il a été le secrétaire de 2000 à 2018 et le président d'avril 2018 à aujourd'hui. Depuis octobre 2020, il est président de la Société espagnole d'histoire des sciences et des techniques, dont il était auparavant vice-président depuis 2014. Antonio est membre de notre Académie depuis 2007. Il sera entouré de deux vice-présidents : Christa Kletter (Autriche), et João Rui Pita (Portugal). Le Portugal devrait prochainement faire partie des nouveaux membres de la Société Internationale d'histoire de la Pharmacie, et il est donc tout à fait légitime que le professeur Pita rejoigne le bureau de notre Académie. Par ailleurs, Anita Magowska reste notre secrétaire et je vais prendre le rôle de trésorier, notre Banque étant actuellement localisée en France depuis plusieurs années. Je souhaite à notre nouveau président et au bureau beaucoup de succès. Nous les retrouverons avec plaisir au Congrès d'Innsbruck en 2026.

Message from the president

Dear colleagues, members of the International Academy of the History of Pharmacy

The year 2024 will soon be coming to an end. As always, the Congress of the International Society for the History of Pharmacy gave us the opportunity to meet our colleagues from different countries and to exchange views on the history of our profession. It was also the venue for our regular meeting of the International Academy of the History of Pharmacy (see below).

This is my last editorial as President of our Academy. It is now over 6 years since I first presided over our assembly. I would like to thank you all for your support during these years of presidency. Our journal *Communications* shows that our members continue to be very active in publishing articles or giving lectures on the history of pharmacy, and we can be delighted about that. Nevertheless, we note that most of our members come from a few countries (too few) and that the next generation is not assured everywhere. We need to give young pharmacists the opportunity to take part in the activities of national societies and international congresses as often as possible.

As president, I hand over to our colleague Antonio González Bueno from Spain, who has a very good knowledge of the history of our

profession and has many responsibilities in this field in Spain, in particular as Director of the Museum of the History of Pharmacy (UCB). He has a Doctor of Biological Sciences degree from the Autonomous University of Madrid (1986) and has been Professor of the History of Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Legislation at Madrid's Complutense University since 2011. He helped set up the Spanish Society of University Professors of the History of Pharmacy (SDUHFE), of which he was secretary from 2000 to 2018 and president from April 2018 to the present. Since October 2020, he has been president of the Spanish Society for the History of Science and Technology, of which he was previously vice-president since 2014. Antonio has been a member of our Academy since 2007.

Antonio will be supported by two vice-presidents: Christa Kletter (Austria), and João Rui Pita (Portugal). Portugal will soon be among the new members of the International Society for the History of Pharmacy, so it is only fitting that Professor Pita should join the Board of our Academy. In addition, Anita Magowska remains as our secretary and I will take on the role of treasurer, as our Bank has been located in France for several years.

I wish our new President and Board every success. We look forward to seeing them and meeting up again at the Innsbruck Congress in 2026.

Nécrologies / Obituaries

Leonardo COLAPINTO (1931-2023)



A member of the International Academy of the History of Pharmacy since 1995, Leonardo Colapinto was a leading figure in the profession, enlightened scholar and popularizer, in particular with his lessons on the History of Pharmacy, a subject taught for many years at the Sapienza University of Rome and of which he was one of the most authoritative teachers at a national level and beyond.

Even more than his intense professional commitment, he spent in every possible field (from trade unions and professional acronyms to distribution and service cooperatives, passing through cultural institutions, above all the First University of Rome and the Nobile Collegio Chimico Farmaceutico, of which he was one of the most appreciated presidents and was still honorary president, Colapinto's will remain forever - together with his legacy made up of books and essays, various publications, research and lessons, in particular on historical matters - the luminous and enlightening legacy of his approach to the profession and more generally to life and others. His cheerful, authentic and sincere smile will remain, never of circumstance. His ability to always spend it to the best of

his ability, now to diffuse a moment of tension, now to encourage or reassure, now simply to admit - in the most complicated situations - that the life, it's true, unfortunately also holds many worries, but we live it much better if "we learn not to worry too much about worries", as he happened to remember.

Lucas Richert, AIHP's Executive Director, reported:

The new issue of "History of Pharmacy and Pharmaceuticals" is available.

The American Institute of the History of Pharmacy has begun its end of year gift giving campaign. The AIHP's staff have identified some areas of need. Those areas are meant to help them "kickstart AIHP", "enhance our collections", and "connect and share" with its members and the public.

Videos from the AIHP's recent "Community Pharmacy" kreminar are now watchable.

The AIHP, Urdang Lab, and the Alcohol and Drug History Society recently held a "Madison Drug History Conference" at the UW-Madison School of Pharmacy. The workshop program was diverse and stay tuned for some of the outputs from the event.

Suisse / Switzerland

In Berne, Switzerland, a new course of study in pharmacy was introduced a few years ago which now offers pursuing a Master's degree in the History of Pharmacy. Therefore, a master course in the history of pharmacy was developed at the University of Bern, for the first time in 2024. Three students used this unique offer and investigated topics of the history of medicinal plants and options for modern pharmaceutical discovery and research and Ex libris of Swiss apothecaries. The works were directed by the two academicians, Sabine Anagnostou and François Ledermann, and by Sara Ruppen, lecturer at Zurich Polytechnic. Laudatio. Awarding of the Schelenz Plakette 2024 to Prof. Dr. Stuart Anderson

The Schelenz Kommission has decided again to award the Schelenz Plakette for an outstanding life work in the history of pharmacy.

Investigating and exploring the history of pharmacy can open new perspectives for activities in the present pharmacy, can encourage new efforts to strengthen our profession and even open new fields of investigation combining the history of pharmacy with the other pharmaceutical disciplines.

For highest merits and an impressive life work in the history of pharmacy, the Schelenz Kommission decided to award the Schelenz Plakette 2024 to Stuart Anderson.

Stuart Anderson is Professor Emeritus for History of Pharmacy and was Acting Dean of Education at the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine. Stuart Anderson is an educated pharmacist and looks back on an impressive career: He gained his PhD degree at the Birkbeck College at the University of London and dedicated his life to the history of Pharmacy by teaching, investigating and publishing.

His principal areas of research have been topics in the social history of pharmacy in Great Britain, the pharmacy's historical role in public health, and the pharmacy's role in the British Empire.

Stuart Anderson continues to undertake a wide range of research, most recently on the shifting historical relationship between pharmacy, medicine and chemistry.

He published many books on various topics of the history of Pharmacy as author and editor. His impressive scientific work comprises more than 90 articles in peer reviewed journals and he contributed about nearly 40 chapters to books.

Since 2017, Professor Anderson is editing the famous “Pharmaceutical Historian”, the international journal in the history of pharmacy. Previously, he was a member of the Editorial Boards for “Social History of Medicine” and “Social History of Alcohol and Drugs”.

Above all, he holds various honors and recognitions and his scientific work has been awarded with high prizes like the Evans Gold Medal in 1994 by the Guild of Healthcare Pharmacists for an outstanding contribution to pharmacy at the national level, the Leslie Matthews Medal by the British Society for the History of Pharmacy in 2011 and the George Urdang Medal by the American Institute of the History of Pharmacy.

Professor Anderson is member of high-level scientific Committees and Academies: From 2009 till 2017, he served as president of the International Academy of the History of Pharmacy. He is a long-standing member of the British Society for the History of Pharmacy Executive Committee and also served here as a vice-president and president.

Stuart Anderson was member, treasurer and chairman of the Executive Committee of the Society for the Social History of Medicine. He is member of the Management Committee for the Center for History in Public Health at the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine.

Professor Anderson moreover chairs Adjudicating Committees and is a highly valued member of Conference Scientific Committees,

and Research Advisory Boards; presently he is providing scientific advice to the “Chemist to the Nation, Pharmacy to the World” project at the University at Nottingham.

Thank you very much, Stuart Anderson for your professional and enthusiastic dedication to the history of pharmacy. With your extraordinary scientific achievements you not only contributed to the visibility and perception of the history of pharmacy. The excellence of your scientific work promoted the positioning of the history of pharmacy in science as an integral part of pharmacy.

May your dedication be a shining example and an encouragement for us all and especially for our young colleagues who start their way in the history of pharmacy.

We wish you all the best for your future work and we are looking forward to many interesting and exciting investigations and publications to come from your side!
