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Message du président

Chers membres de l'Académie Internationale/ Chers collègues,

La Commission européenne a mis à jour, par la Directive déléguée (UE) 2024/782 de la Commission du 4 mars 2024, une modification de la Directive 2005/36/CE du Parlement européen et du Conseil concernant les exigences minimales de formation pour la profession de pharmacien.

La mise en œuvre de cette réglementation dans les pays européens nécessite la révision des programmes menant à l'obtention des diplômes de Licence permettant l'exercice de la profession.

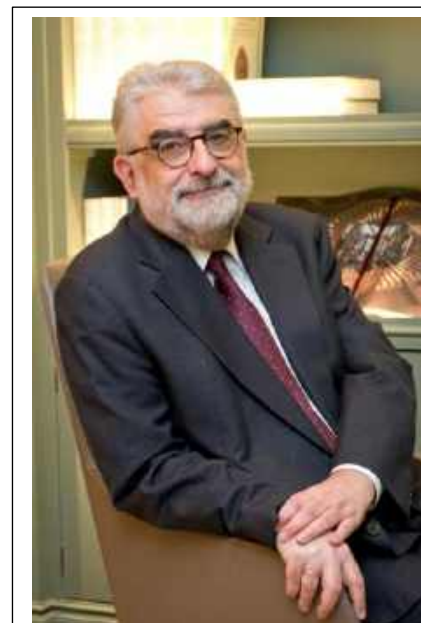
Parmi d'autres compétences, les futurs pharmaciens doivent être capables d'adopter, dans leur pratique professionnelle, une approche critique, créative et fondée sur la méthode scientifique, et d'acquérir les connaissances nécessaires à la recherche dans le domaine pharmaceutique.

L'acquisition de ces compétences nécessite l'intégration, dans l'enseignement universitaire, d'un module de Pharmacie Sociale et de Soins Pharmaceutiques, qui doit permettre de connaître l'histoire et la fonction sociale de la pharmacie, d'identifier les inégalités sociales, politiques et économiques influant sur l'accès

aux soins, et de promouvoir, à cet égard, des actions de sensibilisation, d'éducation et de coopération.

Il s'agit d'un domaine d'enseignement transversal dans lequel la présence des historiens de la pharmacie est essentielle, car nous sommes appelés à participer à la formation de nos futurs collègues. Cette formation historique permettra d'intégrer dans l'éducation des pharmaciens des valeurs et des compétences professionnelles essentielles.

L'Histoire de la Pharmacie constitue un outil fondamental, non seulement pour la formation des professionnels de la pharmacie, mais aussi pour interpréter la situation actuelle de la profession — variable selon les conditions politiques et sociales de chaque territoire— et ainsi analyser les causes de cette situation spécifique et, par l'évaluation comparative de situations historiques analogues, envisager les perspectives d'avenir.



L'étude du passé historique de la profession constitue un excellent instrument pour comprendre le présent et anticiper l'avenir. Connaître l'évolution des systèmes thérapeutiques, des sciences de la santé et des groupes professionnels ; analyser la manière dont ces groupes interagissent avec le reste de la société et examiner les conflits survenus au fil du temps —entre science et croyance, science et culture, profession et économie, science et pouvoir— constitue un cadre précieux pour comprendre la situation actuelle et l'avenir de la profession.

La réflexion sereine et approfondie sur le passé favorise une plus grande clarté et dignité de la pensée et entraîne une augmentation de la liberté personnelle et intellectuelle : celui qui possède la connaissance peut choisir avec plus de sérénité et de discernement. Seule la réflexion sur notre passé offre la clarté intellectuelle nécessaire pour interpréter le présent.

Message from the President

Dear Members of the International Academy / Dear Colleagues,

The European Commission, through Commission Delegated Directive (EU) 2024/782 of 4 March 2024, introduced an amendment to Directive 2005/36/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council concerning the minimum training requirements for the pharmacy profession. The implementation of this regulation across European countries requires the revision of curricula leading to Bachelor's degrees that confer eligibility for professional practice.

Among other competencies, future pharmacists must be able to apply a critical, creative, and scientifically grounded approach to professional pharmaceutical practice, and they must acquire the

knowledge necessary to engage in research within the pharmaceutical field.

The attainment of these competencies requires the inclusion, within university education, of a module on Social Pharmacy and Pharmaceutical Care. This module should provide an understanding of the history and social function of Pharmacy; identify the social, political, and economic inequalities that influence access to healthcare; and promote awareness-raising, educational, and cooperative initiatives in this regard.

This is a cross-disciplinary educational field in which the presence of historians of pharmacy is essential, as we are called to take part in the education of our future colleagues. Such historical training enables the incorporation of fundamental professional values and competencies into the education of pharmacists.

The History of Pharmacy is not only a basic tool for the education of pharmaceutical professionals but also an indispensable means of interpreting the current circumstances of the profession—circumstances that differ according to the political and social conditions of each region. It allows for the analysis of the factors leading to these specific situations and, through comparative assessment of analogous historical contexts, for the anticipation of future developments.

The study of the historical evolution of the profession constitutes an excellent instrument for understanding the present and envisioning the future. Understanding how therapeutic systems, health sciences, and professional groups have evolved; analyzing the ways in which these groups have interacted with society; and examining the conflicts that have arisen over time—between science and belief, science and culture, profession and economy, science and power—provide an invaluable framework for comprehending both the current state and the future of the profession.

Calm and deliberate reflection on the past provides greater clarity and dignity of thought, which, in turn, enhances personal and

intellectual freedom: those who possess knowledge are able to choose with greater confidence and wisdom. Only through reflection on our past can we achieve the intellectual clarity necessary to interpret the present.

Botschaft des Präsidenten

Sehr geehrte Mitglieder der Internationalen Akademie, liebe Kolleginnen und Kollegen,

Die Europäische Kommission hat mit der Delegierten Richtlinie (EU) 2024/782 der Kommission vom 4. März 2024 eine Änderung der Richtlinie 2005/36/EG des Europäischen Parlaments und des Rates hinsichtlich der Mindestanforderungen an die Ausbildung für den Beruf des Apothekers vorgenommen.

Die Umsetzung dieser Vorschrift in den europäischen Ländern erfordert eine Anpassung der Studienpläne, die zum Erwerb der Bachelorabschlüsse führen, welche zur Ausübung des Apothekerberufs berechtigen.

Unter anderem müssen künftige Apothekerinnen und Apotheker in der Lage sein, in ihrer beruflichen Tätigkeit einen kritischen, kreativen und auf der wissenschaftlichen Methode basierenden

Ansatz zu entwickeln und die notwendigen Kenntnisse im Bereich der pharmazeutischen Forschung zu erwerben.

Die Erreichung dieser Kompetenzen erfordert die Entwicklung eines Lehrmoduls „Soziale Pharmazie und pharmazeutische Betreuung“ in der universitären Ausbildung. Dieses Modul soll ein Verständnis für die Geschichte und die soziale Funktion der Pharmazie vermitteln, soziale, politische und wirtschaftliche Ungleichheiten identifizieren, die den Zugang zur Gesundheitsversorgung beeinflussen, sowie in diesem Zusammenhang Sensibilisierungs-, Bildungs- und Kooperationsmaßnahmen fördern.

Es handelt sich um ein interdisziplinäres Bildungsfeld, in dem die Anwesenheit der Pharmaziehistorikerinnen und -historiker von entscheidender Bedeutung ist, da wir aufgerufen sind, an der Ausbildung unserer zukünftigen Berufskolleginnen und -kollegen mitzuwirken. Diese historische Bildung ermöglicht es, wesentliche berufliche Werte und Kompetenzen in die Ausbildung der Apothekerschaft zu integrieren.

Die Geschichte der Pharmazie ist nicht nur ein grundlegendes Instrument für die Ausbildung der Fachleute im Arzneimittelwesen, sondern auch ein unverzichtbares Mittel zur Interpretation der aktuellen Situation des Berufs – einer Situation, die je nach den politischen und sozialen Rahmenbedingungen der jeweiligen Region unterschiedlich ist. Sie erlaubt es, die Ursachen, die zu dieser spezifischen Lage führen, zu analysieren und durch den vergleichenden historischen Blick auf analoge Situationen künftige Entwicklungen zu antizipieren.

Das Studium der historischen Entwicklung des Berufs ist ein hervorragendes Instrument, um die Gegenwart zu verstehen und die Zukunft zu erahnen. Das Wissen darum, wie sich therapeutische Systeme, Gesundheitswissenschaften und Berufsgruppen entwickelt haben; die Analyse, wie diese Gruppen mit der übrigen Gesellschaft interagieren, sowie die Betrachtung der im Laufe der Zeit entstandenen Spannungen – zwischen

Wissenschaft und Glaube, Wissenschaft und Kultur, Beruf und Wirtschaft, Wissenschaft und Macht – bilden einen hervorragenden Rahmen, um die aktuelle Lage und die zukünftige Entwicklung des Berufs zu verstehen.

Eine ruhige und besonnene Reflexion über die Vergangenheit fördert größere Klarheit und Würde des Denkens und führt zu einem Zuwachs an persönlicher und intellektueller Freiheit: Wer Wissen besitzt, kann mit größerer Gelassenheit und Weisheit wählen. Nur die Auseinandersetzung mit unserer Vergangenheit verschafft uns die notwendige intellektuelle Klarheit, um die Gegenwart richtig zu deuten.

Mensaje del presidente

Apreciados miembros de la Academia Internacional / Queridos colegas

La Comisión Europea actualizó, mediante la Directiva Delegada (UE) 2024/782 de la Comisión de 4 de marzo de 2024, una modificación de la Directiva 2005/36/CE del Parlamento Europeo y del Consejo en lo relativo a los requisitos mínimos de formación para la profesión de farmacéutico.

La aplicación de esta normativa en los países europeos requiere de la modificación de los planes de estudios conducentes a la obtención de los títulos de Grado que habiliten para el ejercicio de la profesión.

Entre otras competencias, los futuros farmacéuticos deberán saber desarrollar en la actividad profesional farmacéutica un enfoque crítico, creativo y basado en el método científico y adquirir los conocimientos necesarios en materia de investigación dentro del ámbito farmacéutico.

La consecución de estas habilidades obliga a desarrollar en la docencia universitaria un módulo de Farmacia Social y Atención Farmacéutica, desde el que se debe conocer la historia y función social de la Farmacia; identificar las desigualdades sociales, políticas y económicas que influyen en el ámbito del acceso a la salud así como promover en este sentido acciones de sensibilización, educación y cooperación.

Un ámbito, de educación transversal, en la que presencia de los historiadores de la farmacia estamos llamados a participar en la formación de nuestros futuros compañeros de profesión. Esta formación histórica permitirá incorporar en la formación de los farmacéuticos unos valores profesionales y competencias imprescindibles.

La Historia de la Farmacia es una herramienta básica, no sólo para la formación del profesional del medicamento, sino para la interpretación misma de la situación actual por la que atraviesa la profesión -distinta en función de los condicionantes políticos y sociales de cada ámbito territorial-, y así analizar las causas que conducen a esa situación concreta y, a través de la valoración comparativa de situaciones históricas similares, intuir perspectivas de futuro.

El estudio sobre el pasado histórico de la profesión es un excelente instrumento para comprender el presente e intuir el futuro. El conocer cómo han evolucionado los sistemas terapéuticos, las ciencias de la salud o los colectivos profesionales; el analizar la

manera en que estos colectivos se entremezclan con el resto de la sociedad y los conflictos ocasionados, a lo largo de los tiempos, entre ciencia y creencia; ciencia y cultura; profesión y economía; ciencia y poder... constituyen un excelente mecanismo para comprender la situación actual y el devenir de la profesión. La reflexión, serena y meditada, sobre el pasado proporciona una mayor claridad y dignidad de pensamiento y, de ello, se deriva un incremento de la libertad, personal e intelectual: quien conoce puede elegir con mayor tranquilidad y acierto. Sólo la reflexión sobre nuestro pasado permite disponer de la suficiente claridad intelectual para interpretar el presente.

Prof. María del Carmen Francés Causapé (1944–2025)



We regret to inform you that on May 2, 2025, Prof. Maria del Carmen Francés Causapé, an outstanding historian of pharmacy and president of the International Academy of the History of Pharmacy in 1995-2001, died. She was a long-time professor of

history of pharmacy and pharmaceutical legislation at the Faculty of Pharmacy of the Complutense University of Madrid.

For her significant scientific achievements she became full member of the Royal National Academy of Pharmacy (1995), honorary collegiate of the Nobile Collegio Chimico-Farmacéutico di Roma (1994), corresponding academic: of the Royal Academy of Doctors and the National Academies of Medicine and of Pharmacy and Biochemistry of Buenos Aires of Argentina (1997), of the Peruvian Academy of Pharmacy (1998), of the Academy of Pharmaceutical Sciences of Chile (2000) and of the Royal Academy of Pharmacy of Catalonia (2001). Moreover, Prof. Maria del Carmen Francés Causapé was honorary member: of the Cercle Benelux d'Histoire de la Pharmacie (1995), of the Peruvian Society of Pharmacy History (1996), of the Argentine Society of Pharmacy History (1997) and of the Argentine Pharmaceutical Confederation (1997).

She received research awards from the Royal Academy of Pharmacy IBYS (1975) and ANTIBIOTICS (1976), Carracido Medal, bronze category, from the Royal Academy of Pharmacy (1995). Giulio Conci Award from the Accademia Italiana di Storia della Farmacia (1997); medals from the UCM Faculty of Pharmacy: Bronze (1988), Silver (1992) and Gold (1997). Since 1998, she was Member of the "José Casares Gil" Foundation of Friends of the Royal Academy of Pharmacy.

France

La Société d'histoire de la pharmacie poursuit ses activités : nous avons eu deux expositions à la Faculté de Pharmacie de Paris en 2025 : une première sur *Histoire, Pharmacie & pédiatrie du biberon au médicament* (3 au 14 février 2025) d'une part, et sur les *pharmacies portatives et troussees de secours du XVIIIe siècle à nos jours* (20 septembre au 3 octobre 2025). Nous allons tenir 5 séances de communications dont une lors d'une séance délocalisée à Lyon. Notre revue d'histoire de la pharmacie sera éditée 4 fois au cours de l'année 2025.

The French Society of History of Pharmacy continues its activities: we held two exhibitions at the Faculty of Pharmacy in Paris in 2025: the first on *History, Pharmacy & Pediatrics from Baby Bottles to Medicines* (February 3 to 14, 2025) and the second on *Portable Pharmacies and First Aid Kits from the 18th Century to the Present Day* (September 20 to October 3, 2025). We will hold five communication sessions, including one during a session relocated to Lyon. Our journal on the history of pharmacy will be published four times during 2025.

Hong Kong Society for the History of Pharmacy

As the fourth quarter of 2025 has just commenced, I am delighted to extend my warmest regards to every member in the upcoming autumn and winter months.

The first three quarters of 2025 were as busy as the previous year, and a few key events and publications made this year as colourful as ever.

In the last week of April, a visit to the historical Southwest School of Pharmacy of Sichuan University (previously called West China Union University, WCUU) while attending the 3rd Cross Strait Hospital Pharmacy Conference in Chengdu, Mainland China. Established as part of the Faculty of Science by Dr. Edwin Meuser (1880-1970), a Canadian Christian missionary, in 1932, it remains a top 5 school of pharmacy in 2025 with the original 1920 pharmacy building, The Vandeman Memorial Hall, rebuilt in 1960 and still intact (Fig. 1).

An authors' workshop was set up in June in Taipei to form a working group for the compilation of the Taiwan volume of the *Handbook of History of Pharmacy in Asia*, a major reference work (MRW) to be launched at the 2026 Biannual Conference of the Federation of the Asia Pharmaceutical Associations in Bangkok on November 3, 2026. Dr. Ming Kung Yeh, a Doctor of Pharmacy from the University of Nottingham, who was the first director general of the Taiwan Food and Drug Administration from 2013-2014, will be the responsible editor for the Taiwan volume (Fig. 2). The other countries and regions committed to the Handbook project include Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, the Philippines, and Thailand.

The first edition of the *Handbook* will now cover Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Philippines, Taiwan, and Thailand, with each as a separate volume. The contents will include the beginnings of

pharmacy from antiquity to the present of each country and region, including traditional practices such as Ayurvedic and Unani medicine, acupuncture and qigong, Jamu etc in North and South and Southeast Asia.

In August, I was fortunate to publish the Traditional Chinese language version of "A History of Western Pharmacy in China" (Fig. 1) through the City University of Hong Kong Press at the 2025 Hong Kong Book Fair.

In September, two articles were finalized for publication in the October 2025 edition: *The Evolving Pharmacy Landscape in Hong Kong: 1949–2025*, published in the *Journal of Chinese Culture and Medicine*, and *The Hong Kong Formulary of 1950*, featured in the *Hong Kong Medical Journal*.

In the final quarter of 2025, Dr. Michael Liu, professor at the Asian Studies Centre, University of Pittsburgh, PA, and I are completing the six-volume *Handbook of Chinese History of Pharmacy*. This monumental reference work (MRW) provides a comprehensive account of the history of Chinese medicine and pharmacy from 1 BCE to the present. It will be the first and only MRW dedicated to the history of both traditional and contemporary pharmacy in China. The MRW will be released online, volume by volume, starting in November 2025 through Springer. 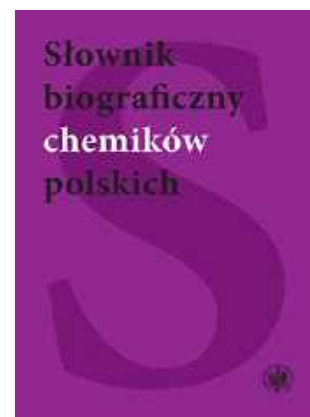

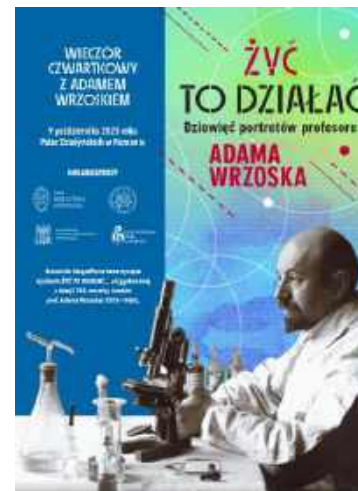

Halil Tekiner

In 2025, Prof. Dr. Halil Tekiner (Erciyes University, Kayseri) maintained an intensive schedule as President of the International Society for the History of Pharmacy alongside his independent research, publishing and collecting activities. On 22 February in Ankara, at the 6th Pharmaceutical Horizons Congress (Lokman Hekim University Faculty of Pharmacy), he delivered “Aesthetics of Science: Interactions between Art and Pharmacy.” On 24 April in

Brno, Czechia, at Masaryk University Faculty of Pharmacy, he presented “History as a Professional Compass in Pharmacy,” examining how historical inquiry supports professional identity and ethical reasoning.

On 9 May in Mardin, under the auspices of the Mardin Chamber of Pharmacists, he spoke at Kasımiye Madrasa—a fifteenth-century educational complex—on “Pharmaceutical Ethics and Professional Values in the History of Pharmacy.” On the same day, he curated “Pharmacists’ Memoirs from the Halil Tekiner Collection: One Profession, Twenty-One Testimonies,” an exhibition combining book covers, concise author biographies, and selected excerpts to offer a compact panorama of professional memory and experience.

On 17–18 May in Vercelli, Italy, at the 74th National Congress for the History of Pharmacy, he delivered “Pharmacy, Poisons, and Quackery in the Works of Gaetano Donizetti,” and, during the Society’s National Meeting, was elected an Honorary Member of the Accademia Italiana di Storia della Farmacia (Italian Academy for the History of Pharmacy). He also met with Academy colleagues, including Prof. Chiara Beatrice Vicentini (Italy) and Prof. Dr. François Ledermann (Switzerland). His international

conference activity continued on 5–6 June in Bucharest, Romania, at the 38th Balkan Medical Week, where he presented “Apothecaries in Comic Opera: Depictions by Haydn, Dittersdorf, and Donizetti,” incorporating brief musical excerpts to illuminate historical and dramaturgical points. While in Bucharest on 6 June, he met Prof. Dr. Adriana-Elena Tăerel—President of the Romanian Society for the History of Pharmacy and a member of the International Academy—at the Faculty of Pharmacy, “Carol Davila” University of Medicine and Pharmacy, Bucharest; together they visited the University’s Pharmacy Museum.

During the year, teaching activities expanded with a new elective at the Erciyes University School of Medicine on the History of Medicine and Pharmacy in Anatolia (present-day Türkiye). In September 2025, editorial service and journal development advanced as the *Journal of Clinical Practice and Research* (Erciyes University)—where H. Tekiner serves as Managing Editor and leads the Medico-Pharmaceutical History section—was accepted for indexing in PubMed, enhancing discoverability and offering a strong new venue for submissions in the history of pharmacy.

Alain Touwaide

Alain Touwaide has been honored by a major publication in recognition of his activity over the past 50 years: *Manuscripts, Plants, Remedies in the Mediterranean Traditions: Studies across Disciplines for Alain Touwaide*.

Masterfully edited by Prof. Steven Oberhelman, and published by the prestigious scholarly publisher De Gruyter-Brill (Berlin and Boston, MA), this 3-volume set of essays with a total of over 2.400 pages, is dedicated to Alain. The 80 essays, in six languages and written by 100 international scholars and researchers, are grouped into three broad categories — Manuscripts, Plants, and Remedies — to reflect Alain's main areas of research.

As one of the authors, Prof. Vivian Nutton, emeritus, University College London, put it (see vol. 1, p. 544).

Throughout his career, Alain Touwaide has sought to unite philological studies on ancient medicine with the practical business of healing, whether in the past or today. In particular, his work on the history of pharmacology has advanced our knowledge in many

new ways that have avoided the common accusations of antiquarianism and anachronism.

Two members of the Academy have contributed a paper, the late Dr John Parascandola and Prof. Dr Francois Ledermann.
